

My Father's House Family Place Lubbock Christian Women's Job Corps

Christian Women's Job Corps exists to minister to women in need with a hand up, not a hand-out. This is done by providing a vast array of life skills and job skills training, Bible study, and a missions environment in which women help women. CWJC is a 12-week program where any **woman 18 or older** can receive the following training:

- **Bible study**
- **Communication**
- **Self-defense**
- **Career**
- **English**
- **Math**
- **Anger management**
- **Boundaries**
- **Money matters to God**
- **Computers**

We partner with South Plains College and offer incentives for attendance. A woman can receive continuing education credits on their diploma. Our classes help women score

higher in the Acuplacer test for college entrance and the GED test. The classes are open to resident and non-resident women.

Many women cannot find a job that will support their families because they do not have an education. They do not have an education because they cannot afford child care and they cannot afford child care because they do not have a job.

Buckner My Father's House Lubbock is an ecumenical ministry that provides a way to help women take a new direction through education, to change their lives toward God and to be self-sufficient. Through CWJC classes, we can help women achieve goals that will allow them to provide for themselves and their families.

We offer daytime classes Monday – Friday from 8:30-3:00p.m. Each woman in our program also has the opportunity to get a better job, attend college, pursue a career of her choice or get her GED in-house at our facility on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30 – 9:30p.m.

Women can enroll their children in our on-site day-care when they qualify for child care services.
